Check Parent Portal regularly. Discuss compact during parent conference. Review and assist with homework, review interim reports, report cards, Tuesday Folders, and sign agendas daily.</p>	<p>Strive to improve in your schoolwork by: achieving academic goals, completing classroom and homework assignments, and always trying your best.</p>
<p>Partnership - Be Involved</p>	<p>Provide families with needed resources and activities to encourage academic achievement. Demonstrate professional behavior and positive character traits.</p>	<p>Participate in decisions about your child's education via PTO, committees, surveys, and visiting the website for volunteer opportunities.
