Let's Learn about Title I

•Title I is the largest federal assistance program for our nation's schools.

•The purpose of Title I is to provide supplemental resources and services to high poverty schools, to migratory children and families, and to institutions serving neglected and delinquent children and youth.



How does it work?

The Federal Government

Provides funds to states each year for Title I based on U.S. census poverty data.

State Education Agencies

Sends the money to school districts based on the number of families that receive free and reduced lunch or CEP-Direct Certified.

Send in a plan describing:

*high-quality standards that children are expected to meet

*ways their progress will be measured

*how Title I funds will help children meet expectations



The Local School Districts (LEAs)

Identifies eligible schools and distribute the funds.




Title I helps...
